

This initiative apparently calls for an additional 1000 acres of land (total 1700) to be dedicated as "Open Space" and provides for little or no future development of that land. There is just one major flaw to their plan. . . they don't actually own the land. That, however, doesn't seem to be a stumbling block for them.
