More Than Swimming - Lafayette City Meet

The Sun Valley Suns performed a rigorously choreographed dance routine, the mighty Springbrook Hogs deafened the crowd with their vocal presence and the LMYA Dolphins "sacrificed" their junior coaches by throwing them into the pool. It was, after all, the 42nd Annual Lafayette City Meet.

Swimmers from Las Trampas, LMYA, Oakwood Athletic Club, Rancho Colorados, Springbrook and Sun Valley surely represented much of the Lafayette student population. Each day started off with morning heats and ended with afternoon finals. Once again, the Springbrook Hogs dominated the meet and secured an incredible 1st place finish with 1,355.50 points. 2nd place went to the Rancho Colorados Wahoos with 716 points and the Las Trampas Seahorses placed 3rd with 683 points. Sun Valley, LMYA and Oakwood respectively finished 4th, 5th and 6th.
