 On March 6th, the Board of the Moraga Orinda Fire District (MOFD) decided to appoint a new member to the seat previously held by Pete Wilson, rather than to hold a special election. Interested residents living in Division 3 of the District must submit a letter of interest, with qualifications, by 5:00 p.m. on March 16th; Division 3 encompasses parts of Moraga (southwest) and Orinda (south).
 The Board is also seeking residents who are willing to serve on an appointed Citizens' Ad-hoc Advisory Panel that will help with the selection process. Applications for that panel are also due on March 16th.
