## The Town Of Moraga Relays For Life

Kelly Clancy and Kelly Suronen were the co-captains of Team Town of Moraga at the Relay For Life organized by the American Cancer Society (ACS) last weekend. During the event at the Saint Mary's College campus, members of the Town staff and Moraga's mayor relayed to walk

for 24 hours in support of the cause.

"I was diagnosed with cervical cancer at age 29," says Clancy, "I've been cancer free now for two years." She and Suronen decided to raise money for research.

The purpose of the event is

also to raise awareness about the different forms of cancer and the best ways to prevent and cure them. ACS pledges that all the money collected will go to cancer research. "Many people from the Town came to support us," said Clancy, "Karen Mendonca showed up with Bob Priebe around midnight and stayed for hours; Jill Keimach walked... Marty McInturf...Jill Mercurio, who came at 1:00 a.m. with her daughter Bella; Shawna Brekke Read and her husband walked on Saturday morning; Jay Ingram and his family; Yuliya Elbo, Beth Cowley and Cheryl Briones...they all came, and raised a lot of money. Many of our friends also came to support us."

On site, Moraga Public Works provided tables and canopy and a tent was installed with a bed so the captains could get a few hours sleep during the night. "We raised more than \$2,000," said a proud Clancy.

Another 20 teams participated in the event, mostly composed of Saint Mary's students and faculty.

## Orinda Takes the Lead in Mapping Lamorinda AVA

"LWGA needs a lot of different elements in order to be approved as an AVA," said Smith, "weather data, soil analysis, and also detailed mapping of Lamorinda, and our Orinda Planning Department will be working on creating the Lamorinda map for the AVA."

Ursu also supports the idea of growing grapes in Orinda, but he has a few concerns about the possible impact from an operation standpoint. "We want to make sure that this does not get out of control," he said, adding that he believes that the city's rules are probably already adequate. But he noted that commercial activities, such as selling wine from the home, are not allowed in most of the neighbor-

hoods where the grapes are growing.

"We are not in favor of over-regulating," said Ursu, "as long as the residential character of the neighborhoods are preserved and things are conducted to everyone's satisfaction we do not need to step in." He believes that small-scale operations should not create a problem. "Wine growers can apply for temporary events permits if they want to have a wine tour a few times a year, like a home tour or a garden tour," he says, "Orinda is first and foremost a residential bedroom community, there can be a small, limited amount of agriculture, but no undue impact on surrounding properties." Ursu also expressed

possible aesthetic concerns with grading on hillsides and the potential removal of native vegetation to accommodate vineyards.

"If this really takes off, we could look at what other cities such as St. Helena have done to regulate the activities of the wine growers," added Smith, who believes that these activities would be beneficial to the economics to the region. "We also want the LWGA to be more involved with the city, its events and the Chamber of Commerce," says the Mayor, who would love to see downtown restaurants serving local wines and a tasting facility in the downtown area, "so people from out of town can come and go by BART."
