Transition Classes

Take fun, creative lessons that "work on mastering math facts". Mix that with "writing responses to stories and literature". Stir in "participation in book or story discussions". Knead in "Reviewing important language arts and math concepts". Bake until students have "learned new concepts that are important for success". Finally, consume with "two teachers with 30 years of teaching experience".


