Three bicyclists ride from northern Alaska to the tip of Argentina, 16,000 miles through 13 countries, in support of the National Brain Tumor Society in the documentary *Spinning Southward*. The film will be screened, with a discussion to follow, on Thursday, November 8 from 6:30 to 9 p.m. in the Arts and Science Discovery Room of the Lafayette Library and Learning Center.
