With the goal to never forget the events that happened on Sept. 11, 2001, The Lafayette Flag Brigade will be holding its 13th Annual 9/11 Remembrance and Candlelight Vigil from 4 to 8 p. m. Thursday, Sept. 11 at the El Curtola Bridge, Highway 24 overcrossing near the 680 Freeway in Lafayette.
