Thousands converge downtown for Orinda Classic Car Show

Thousands streamed to Orinda Village on Saturday, Sept. 10, for the 18th Annual Orinda Classic Car show. "Keep on Truckin'" was the theme of this year's show, which was presented by the Orinda Association and benefits the Seniors Around Town transportation program.
